TOGAF® certification

After successfully passing the certification exam, the participant will receive a globally recognized and indefinitely valid certificate issued by The Open Group. The certificate is issued through the portal The Open Group (opengroup.org) in the form of a PDF file, which is available to registered users with the relevant passed exams after logging into this portal.

TOGAF® Enterprise Architecture Foundation Certification Exam

Foundation criteria:

- 40 questions / 60 min. (English as a Second Language – 90 minutes)
- Test in the form of choosing one correct answer from several options
- Open Book: NO
- Proctor Supervision: YES
- You can get the certificate for min. 60% of correct answers

Requirements:

- Basic overview in architecture
- (ICT, Business, Security) / Quality Assurance / Project Management / Service Operations
- Advanced knowledge of English (training materials and certification exams are in English)
- Full concentration and attention during training, willingness to interact when discussing material, proactive
- access, cooperation
- Responsible time investment in preparations and individual exercises assigned by the lecturer

TOGAF® Enterprise Architecture Practitioner certification exam

A candidate can proceed to the Practitioner certification exam if he has successfully passed the TOGAF® Foundation certification exam.

Practitioner criteria:

- 8 questions / 90 min. (English as a Second Language – 135 minutes)
- The questions are designed in the form of prepared scenarios, which must be assessed and one selected
- out of a possible 4 answers for using the TOGAF® framework
- Open Book: YES
- Proctor Supervision: YES
- Candidates must achieve min. 60% of correct answers (24 points out of 40)

Requirements:

- Good practical orientation in architecture (ICT, Business, Security) / Quality Assurance / Project Management / Service Operations
- Professional knowledge of English (training materials, examples, case studies and certification exams are in English)
- Full concentration and attention during training, willingness to interact when discussing material, proactive
- access, cooperation
- Responsible time investment in preparations and individual exercises assigned by the lecturer
